



The efficiency of the ENERSAVE Control System has been documented and supported by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Consumers Energy of Michigan with the distribution of grant money to our customers for the ENERSAVE installations.

ENERSAVE customers have received grants of 50% of system costs in New York through the NYSERDA program. The NYSERDA program is directed toward new construction energy savings and energy reductions when upgrading existing agricultural equipment.

For the replacement of existing refrigeration control equipment and new refrigeration construction, ENERSAVE customers in Michigan have received grants totaling 25% of ENERSAVE Control System costs through the United States Department of Agriculture's - Rural Energy for America Program (REAP).

For the replacement of existing refrigeration control equipment, ENERSAVE customers in Michigan have also received grants of \$.08 per kilowatt saved under ENERSAVE Control System operation through a local utility's Consumers Energy Custom Rebate Program.

For potential customers, ENERSAVE will investigate the availability of and assist in the application of grant opportunities, both state and federal, to help offset installation costs of the ENERSAVE Control System.
